Our Back to School Night (Thurs., Aug. 10, 6:00-8:00) schedule will go as follows:

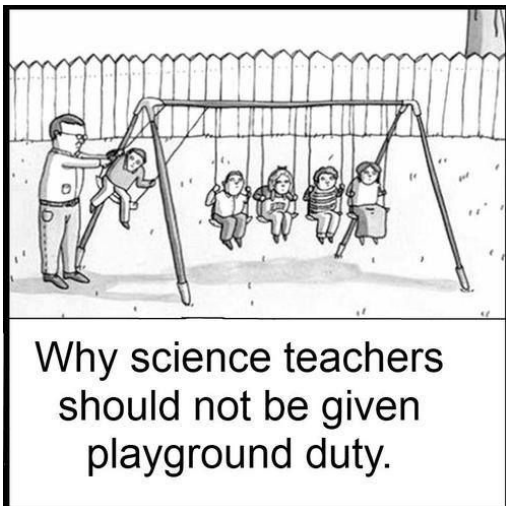
### Back to School Night Open House
